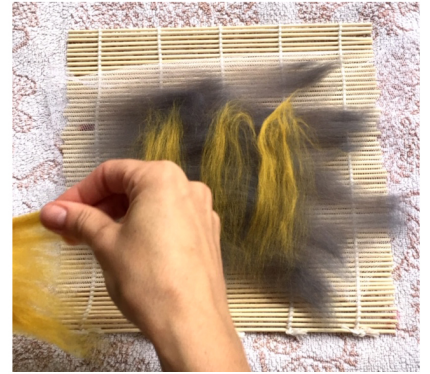
Flat Felting



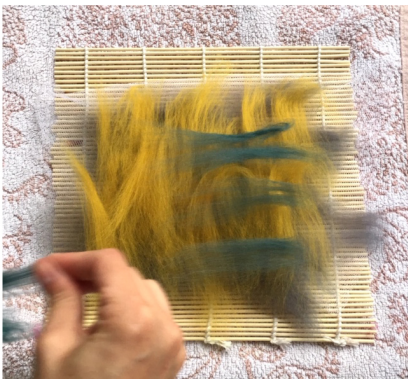
1. Layer towel, mat then one tulle square.



2. Tease fibres from TOP to cover tulle.



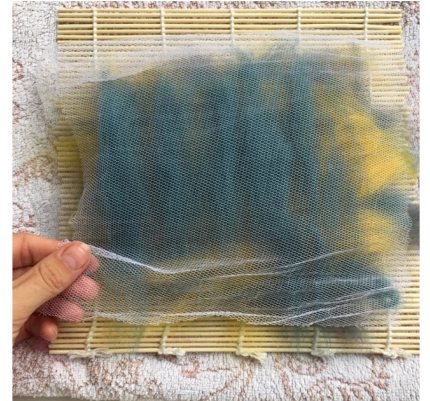
3. Tease second layer in opposite direction.



4. Tease third layer in opposite direction again.



5. Make minimum six layers. Aim for Cake size.



6. Place second tulle square on top.



7. Soak in soapy water. Aim to wet towel.



8. Smooth fibres and tulle.



9. Lift wool within tulle and TURN OVER.



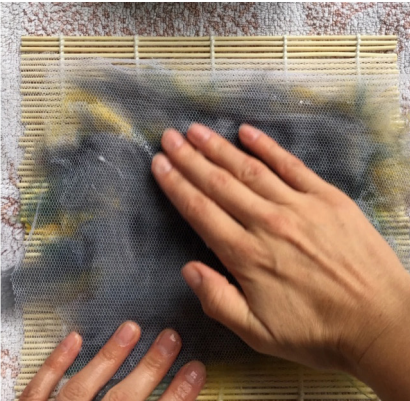
10. Lay down on mat again.



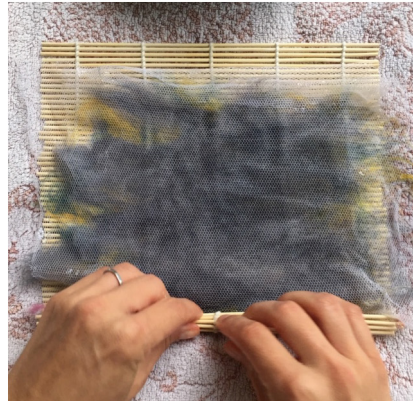
11. Soak this side as before.



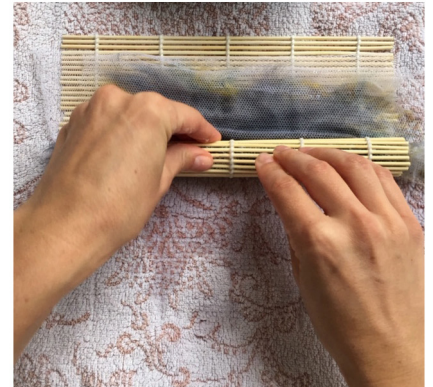
12. Add a few pumps of soap.



13. Smooth again.



14. Begin to tightly roll up the mat.



15. Roll entire mat.



16. Begin aggravation by firmly rolling.



17. Press hard, and roll at least 100 times.



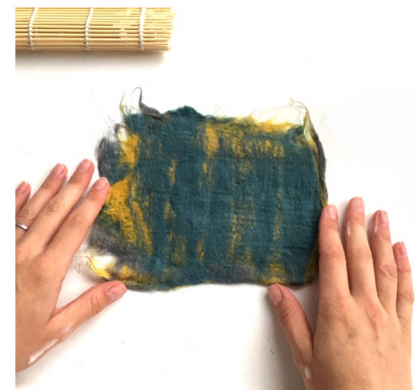
18. Remove and turn 90 degrees.



19. Continue rolling and repeat turning for approx 10 mins.



20. Carefully remove tulle from both sides.



21. A final product will not pull apart.
